PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

A-121 DISC CLEANER is a clear liquid with phosphoric acid, emulsifier, surfactants and penetrating agents, which easily penetrates oxide deposits and oily films on metal surfaces.

PRODUCT USE:

A-121 DISC CLEANER is specially formulated for the removal of tenacious deposits, which collect in fuel and lube oil centrifugal separators.

A-121 DISC CLEANER removes tenacious deposits instantly, speeds up production, and cuts labour cost substantially. It is highly concentrated and easy to use. It contains a specific inhibitor selected to prevent any level attack on metal-substrate during and after treatment.

A-121 DISC CLEANER can also be used on rust, oil stains and copper stains from bulkheads, paintworks and wooden decks etc. It should not be used for cleaning galvanized, aluminium, zinc or tinned surfaces.

APPLICATION:

A-121 DISC CLEANER can be used in its concentrated form or diluted as 1 part of A-121 DISC CLEANER with 4 parts of fresh water, depending on the degree of contamination. It is recommended to soak the separator disc stack into the concentrated solution of A-121 DISC CLEANER in a container for 30 minutes to 3 hours. Heating the solution naturally speeds up the process.

Upon the complete removal of deposits, remove the articles from the container and rinse with water. Accumulated residue at the bottom of the container should be removed regularly to prevent loss of active materials. Topping up with fresh A-121 DISC CLEANER would be essential to maintain a concentrated and effective solution.
